

## Grade 2 Math – Carnival Weekend homework – mini project

Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> February, 2020.

Dear Parents and students,

Over the Carnival weekend, there is a fraction mini-project to be done. Please find the instructions below:

What you will need:

- A piece of letter sized bristol board (  $8\frac{1}{2}$  x 11 inches) in a colour of your choice.  
This is for the base of the project.
- Two more pieces of Bristol board of that are two different colours from the base.  
These two are for your creature. (This means a total of 3 pieces of Bristol board)
- Glue
- Colours
- Ruler, scissors and stationery.
- The “my fraction creature” slip of paper to cut out from this letter.

What to do:

1. Cut out 12 equally sized squares from the 2 pieces of Bristol board. These will be used to create your creature. You can use any combination of colours to make up the total of 12 squares. ( e.g. 6 blue and 6 orange OR 5 blue and 7 orange etc etc).
2. Create your fraction creature. Stick it onto the base piece of Bristol board that is letter sized.
3. Cut out the “my fraction creature” slip of paper from the bottom of this letter and stick it onto your project.
4. Complete the “ my fraction creature slip of paper”
5. Decorate.
