Dear Parents and students,

Over the Carnival weekend, there is a fraction mini-project to be done. Please find the instructions below:

What you will need:

- A piece of letter sized bristol board ($8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$ inches) in a colour of your choice. This is for the base of the project.
- Two more pieces of Bristol board of that are two different colours from the base. These two are for your creature. (This means a total of 3 pieces of Bristol board)
- Glue
- Colours
- Ruler, scissors and stationery.
- The "my fraction creature" slip of paper to cut out from this letter.

What to do:

- 1. Cut out 12 equally sized squares from the 2 pieces of Bristol board. These will be used to create your creature. You can use any combination of colours to make up the total of 12 squares. (e.g. 6 blue and 6 orange OR 5 blue and 7 orange etc etc etc).
- 2. Create your fraction creature. Stick it onto the base piece of Bristol board that is letter sized.
- 3. Cut out the "my fraction creature" slip of paper from the bottom of this letter and stick it onto your project.
- 4. Complete the "my fraction creature slip of paper"
- 5. Decorate.


